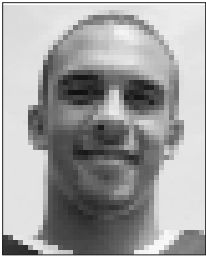

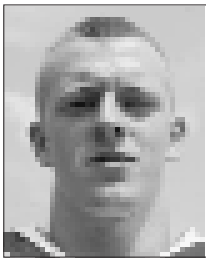
**Defensive Back, Senior, 6-0, 192**
