2008 Season Preview

Despite losing a talented group of seniors, the Springfield College women's lacrosse team, which finished with an overall record of 10-8 last season, returns with an optimistic attitude and ready to contend for the New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference title and a berth to the NCAAs for the third time in four years. A total of 13 players return, but 12 first-year players will make this a fairly young team.

The Pride received a boost when it learned that attacker **Rachel Lampros**, the squad's second-leading goal-scorer (29) and point-scorer (76) last year, was returning as a grad student. She, along with seniors **Lindsay Bugbee** (10 goals), **Lena Johnson**, and **Julia Kincade**, will serve as captains and provide leadership for the team. Sophomores **Alexandra Bazzano** and **Lauren McAulay** will look to improve upon good freshman seasons. Bazzano notched 21 goals from her midfield position, while scooping up 32 ground balls and sporting a .449 success rate from the faceoff area. Bazzano also ranked second on the team in caused turnovers with 20, just one behind graduated team leader and two-time ECAC All-Star **Jaclyn Alessi**.

Team defense is expected to be a strength. Johnson, Kincade, and junior **Meghan Wissel** are all considered very good defenders. And McAulay, a NEWMAC All-Conference Second Team honoree as a freshman, will return to the cage. In her first season at Springfield, she posted an 8.83 goals-against-average along with a .529 save percentage.

Katie Hawke has seen nothing but success on the turf since coming to Springfield College in 2005. Hawke has a three-year coaching record of 34-20 (.630), leading her team to back-to-back New England Women's and Men's Athletic Conference (NEWMAC) championships and two trips to the NCAA Division III Tournament in 2005 and 2006. The NEWMAC has recognized Hawke's efforts twice, naming her Coach of the Year in both 2005 and 2006. She was also named Intercollegiate Women's Lacrosse Coaches Association (IWLCA) Division III Berkshire Regional Coach of the Year after the 2006 campaign.

Before coming to Springfield College, Hawke coached at Mount Holyoke College, where she served as a visiting lecturer in physical education, and assistant women's lacrosse coach and head squash coach.

Prior to joining the staff at Mount Holyoke, Hawke was the head women's lacrosse and field hockey coach at Elms College in Chicopee, Mass. She was voted the North Atlantic Conference (NAC) field hockey Coach of the Year in 2000.

From 1995 to 1999, she was the head of girl's physical education at the Queensbury School in Bradford, England. In 1999, Hawke came to the United States to pursue a master of science degree in exercise and sports studies and to serve as a graduate teaching fellow at Smith College. She was awarded her master's degree in May of 2001, and went on to hold visiting lecturer and coaching positions at Elms College and Mount Holyoke. Hawke graduated with honors with a bachelor of education in physical education from Leeds Metropolitan University in England in May of 1992.
