ATRN Major Program Standards:

In order to qualify for advanced standing as an Athletic Training major and to register for third- and fourth-year sequences of ATRN courses, I must meet the following standards:

- Complete ATRN 110, ATRN 114, ATRN 120, ATRN 227, ATRN 228, ATRN 284, and ATRN 285.
- Complete all **ATRN courses with a B- or better.**
- Complete all other courses required courses for ATRN with a passing grade (no Ws or INCs).
- Achieve a **cumulative GPA of 3.000 or higher** at the conclusion of the first year, and maintain that thereafter.
- Maintaining established Standards of Professional Behavior, including complying with:
 - a. The Student Code of Conduct, as outlined in the *Springfield College Student Handbook*.
 - b. Guidelines set forth for Athletic Training Students by the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, Division of Professional Licensing Board.
 - c. The National Athletic Trainers' Association Code of Ethics as applied to athletic training students.
 - d. Maintaining a C- or better on al Evaluations of Meeting Standards for Professional Behavior conducted in all ATRN classes.
- Meeting all Athletic Training Technical Standards.
