

**SHS APPLICATION FOR YELLOW RIBBON BENEFITS  
POST 9/11 GI BILL VETERANS EDUCATIONAL BENEFITS**

Educational benefits for veterans under Chapter 33 (Post 9/11 GI Bill) will pay tuition up to the maximum of the highest undergraduate rate of tuition at a public college or university in the state of the school that the veteran is attending.

The Yellow Ribbon Program provision of this bill allows institutions to provide a grant for tuition costs over the base maximum rate.

The VA will match the grant provided by the institution up to full tuition costs.

Veterans must be officially accepted for admission and confirm eligibility for Yellow Ribbon with the VA before submitting an application.
