#### **Bookmarking**

Since you will be visiting your online class quite frequently on the Internet, it is a good idea to **bookmark** it so that you can get to it quickly. The web page below provides instructions on how to do this.

#### **Breadcrumbs**

I guess you are wondering-- "What are breadcrumbs?" **Breadcrumb** is the technical term for the series of web pages you have visited that appear on your navigation bar. They are typically created automatically as you visit web page after web page, after web page.

For example, if you are viewing Assignment #2 for a student in your Senior Seminar online course, the navigation bar at the top of the web page window will show all links to web pages that you visited previously.

The breadcrumbs links may look something like the following:

Springfield College > School of Human Services > HUSB Senior Seminar > Assignment #2

If you wanted to get back to the School of Human Services web page, all you have to do is click the link for it. Or you could continue to click "**Back button**" until you reach your desired screen.
